## **Rules & Regulations**

**Introduction:**

This manual governs all Clubs and Chapters under the Department of Computer Science & Engineering, Sister Nivedita University. It ensures smooth functioning, decentralization, and uniform club management.

Only one club per organization is allowed. A club lead cannot head multiple clubs without prior approval from **Geeks for Geeks (GFG)**. New clubs must be approved by the **HOD** and details should be shared with **GFG**. Each club must have designated executives and cannot charge any joining fee unless approved.

## **2. Functioning**

Event dates must be shared in advance to avoid clashes. Proper coordination among clubs is mandatory. Participation in events is voluntary.

## **3. Objectives**

Clubs aim to enhance learning, collaboration, and innovation in Computer Science through workshops, seminars, and technical activities. Focus areas include **Development, AI/ML, Open Source, IoT, DSA, and related domains**.
